Sponsor: Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. Omicron Theta Omega Chapter

Scholarship: \$500 (One Time Award)

Eligibility: Graduating college-bound senior
St. Louis Metropolitan area resident
Demonstrate a financial need
African American Student
Attend & participate at 80% of the #CAP workshop sessions

Not Eligible: A family member of an Omicron Theta Omega Chapter member
(special circumstances considered)

Application Procedures: Typewritten Personal Essay (500 words or less), "Tell us about yourself and your career aspirations?"
Typewritten Personal Essay (150 words or less) on "Tell us about your experience in the #CAP program"
Character Reference Letter (written by a non-family member)
Provide full-time enrollment documentation for the Fall semester
Demonstrate service in the community
Complete the online application
Provide a copy of an unofficial transcript
